

## Love Lives Here Quilt Block

Finished Block Size: 6" x 6" - Unfinished Block Size: 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"



THIS BLOCK IS PART OF RILEY BLAKE'S "FROM OUR HOUSE" QUILT SEW ALONG

You can find the <u>pattern from Riley Blake Designs here</u> and follow their blog to find an alternate block from fabric designers like me each week.

### Read all instructions before cutting fabrics.

- RST = Right Sides Together
- WOF = Width of Fabric
- Cutting instructions are based on 40" WOF.
- Use scant 1/4" seam allowances
- Refer to the pattern cover and diagrams for fabric placement.
- Label pieces as you cut.
- Sew with RST unless otherwise stated.
- Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise.
- Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes unless stated otherwise.



# Fabric 1: • A: (2) 2" x 3 ½" • H: (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" • I: (2) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric 2: • G: (1) 4 ½" x 2 ½" • F: (1) 4 ½" x 1" • E: (2) 1" x 4" • D: (1) 3 ½" x 1" • B: (2) 2" x 2" • C: (4) 1" x 1"



### STEP 1: MAKE THE 31/2" X 31/2" CENTER HEART BLOCK

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all B and C squares.
- Place (2) B squares on (2) A rectangles, RST and with the marked lines as shown.
- Sew on the lines.
- Trim corners leaving 1/4" beyond the stitching.
- Flip the B pieces right side up and press. The size of the larger, original base piece does not change.



- Place (4) C squares on (2) A/B units, RST and with the marked lines as shown.
- Sew on the lines.
- Trim corners leaving 1/4" beyond the stitching.
- Flip the C pieces right side up and press.
- Sew the two halves of the heart block RST and press the center seam open.
- The heart block should measure 3½" x 3½".




### STEP 2: MAKE THE ROOF

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong sides of (2) H squares.
- Place (1) H squaree on top of (1) G rectangle, RST with he marked line as shown.
- Sew on the lines.
- Trim corners leaving 1/4" beyond the stitching.
- Flip the H piece right side up and press.



• Repeat the steps with the other H piece on the opposite side to complete the roof, as shown.




### STEP 3: ASSEMBLE THE HOUSE UNIT

- Sew (1) D rectangle to the bottom of the heart unit.
- Sew (2) E rectangles to each side as shown.
- Sew (1) F rectangle to the top as shown.
- Sew the roof unit on top to complete the house unit as shown.

### STEP 4: ASSEMBLE THE BLOCK

- Sew an I rectangle to each side to complete the block.
- The unfinished block should measure 6 ½" x 6 ½".
