# MAKE A WISH: PAPER DOLL D

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## **FINISHED BLOCK SIZE**

6" × 6"

Please read all instructions before beginning this project. Yardage is calculated using a 42" WOF.

WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

SNF = Stitch and Flip

# **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

Refer to the website: www.sewastory.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.

# **SEWING TECHNIQUES**

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the quilt layout diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Please refer to the following general sewing techniques as these methods are referenced throughout the pattern in their abbreviated form.

# STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance outside the sewn line to ¼". Flip the smaller piece away from the larger piece and press, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.



## FUSIBLE APPLIQUÉ METHOD

Trace the appliqué pattern on the paper side of lightweight fusible web. Cut out the piece, leaving ¼" around the shape. If desired, cut out the center of the fusible web shape, leaving a ¼" around the inside of the shape to make appliqué soft and easier to quilt. Place the fusible web shape, paper side up, onto the wrong side of the fabric. Follow the manufacturer's directions for pressing and fusing together. Let cool. Cut the piece out directly on the traced line. Remove paper back from shape and layout the appliqué piece according to the placement directions. Fuse in place following the manufacturer's directions for pressing. Use your machine and the stitch of your choice to sew around the edges of the appliqué shape.




# DAX (PAPER DOLL D) BLOCK

# **TEMPLATE**


For accurate template sizing, always print template pages at "ACTUAL SIZE", not "FIT TO PRINT". After printing, measure the TEST 1" square to ensure the template printed at the correct size BEFORE cutting any fabric.




This should measure 1" square.

### ASSEMBLE THE PAPER DOLL D BLOCK

1. Gather the required pieces and use the SNF method to make one of each of the units shown below, referencing the diagrams for quantity, proper placement, and orientation.




2. Sew (1) **O**-rectangle to each side of the required SNF unit. Next, add (1) **N**-rectangle to the top. Use the SNF method to add (1) **G**-square to each corner to make (1) Face Unit.




3. Sew (2) H-rectangles and (1) U-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) Neck Unit.




4. Sew (1) **A**-square to each side of (1) Face Unit. Next, add the Neck Unit to the bottom to make (1) Head Unit.




- 5. Sew (1) **M**-rectangle and (1) **S**-rectangle together to make (1) Leg Unit. Repeat to make a second unit.
- 6. Sew (2) Leg Units and (1) **F**-rectangle together as shown below. Next, add (1) **J**-square and (1) **L**-rectangle to the top to make (1) Body Unit.




7. Use the SNF method to add (1)  $\bf R$ -square and (1)  $\bf T$ -square to opposite corners of (1)  $\bf B$ -rectangle as shown below. Next, add (1)  $\bf G$ -square to the  $\bf R$ -square corner to make (1) Left Arm Unit and (1) Right Arm Unit.







8. Sew (1) **D**-rectangle, (1) required SNF unit, (1) **C**-rectangle and (1) Left or Right Arm Unit together in pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make (1) Left Side Unit and (1) Right Side Unit.



9. Sew (1) Left Side Unit, (1) Body Unit, and (1) Right Side Unit together as shown below. Next, add (1) Head Unit to the top to complete the Paper Doll D block.



10. If desired, add optional star appliqués using the Fusible Appliqué method as shown, right. Use hand or machine stitches to add a line from Dax's hand to (1) star to make a wand.
